

COMPUTER AND INTERNET SERVICES

We provide free Internet services on a first come-first served basis. We ask that you sign in on the sheet provided and sign out when you are finished. Time limits are generally 30 minutes for children and an hour for adults. Those under 16 need parental permission to use the Internet. Forms are available at the front desk.

Only sites appropriate for public settings should be visited.

We also have one computer for young children to use. It has a wide variety of age appropriate software that is both fun and educational.

Staff will provide assistance in the use of computers as time provides.

If you wish to print, we charge \$.25 per page (\$.10 for school and work related materials)

VOLUNTEERS

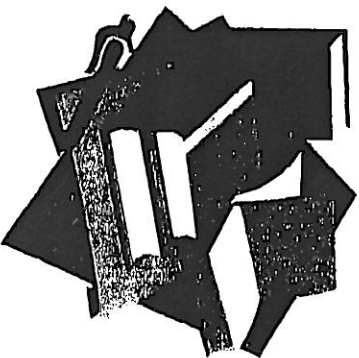
