A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF WEST COVE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CONTROL AND REGULATE THE DRAINAGE WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF WEST COVE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of West Cove, in the Province of Alberta pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Section 177, R.S.A. 1980, and amendments thereto, deems it necessary to provide a by-law to control and regulate drainage within the limits of the Summer Village of West Cove, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of West Cove deems it necessary to control and regulate the size, length, and grade level of culverts installed in the Summer Village of West Cove.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Summer Village of West Cove in the province of Alberta enacts as follows:

- No person or persons shall obstruct any drainage ditch or impede the flow of water within the Summer Village of West Cove.
- 2. All driveways into residential properties shall have a culvert of 12 inches (300mm) in diameter and shall be 20 feet (6m) in length, excepting those streets designated as main drainage routes, culvert sizes and lengths are to be determined by the Development Officer.
- All culverts shall be installed at the direction of the Summer Village of West Cove so as to retain proper grade level and drainage within the Village.
- No person or persons shall install any culvert within the Summer Village of West Cove without authorization of the Development Officer.
- 5. No person or persons shall pump, discharge or drain any water, effluent, sewage or liquid of any type into a drainage ditch within the limits of the Summer Village of West Cove, without the authorization of the Development Officer.
