

BY LAW NO. 420-16
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
SUMMER VILLAGE OF WEST COVE

BEING A BYLAW OF the Summer Village of West Cove in the Province of Alberta to
impose penalties on unpaid taxes.

WHEREAS, Section 344 and 345 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M26, R.S.A. 2000, permits Council to pass a bylaw to impose a penalty on unpaid taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of West Cove, in the province of Alberta, deems it expedient to impose penalties on unpaid taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Taxes in the Summer Village of West Cove are due and payable by June 30th, for the year in which the taxes are levied;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of West Cove enacts as follows;

1. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy an 18% penalty on the current year's outstanding taxes not paid by June 30th, on July 1st, for the year in which the taxes are levied.
2. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy an 18% penalty on all outstanding taxes not paid by December 31st, on January 1st, and an additional 18% penalty each succeeding year thereafter, so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

THAT, this bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the third reading and signing thereof.

Unanimous consent to do a third reading this 24th day of November AD 2016.

Read a third time this 24th day of November AD 2016.
