SUMMER VILLAGE OF WEST COVE

**A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST COVE, IN THE PROVINCE OF
ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 2000, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties, and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of West Cove, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the position of Assessor be established to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
2. That as the Summer Village has entered into an agreement with Municipal Assessment Services Group for the provision of assessment services within the Summer Village, Dan Kanuka be appointed Assessor for the Summer Village of West Cove.
3. That this bylaw is effective upon the date of its third and final reading and upon signing thereof.
