

Summer Village of West Cove Annual Information Meeting Items for follow up – July 2019

1. Costs for Large Bin cleanup: *The cost for 5 large bins is approximately \$6,912.00, Council discussed holding a cleanup with another municipality in a future year or contacting the regional landfill site to set up a date for West Cove residents to use the site at no charge.*
2. Municipal Development Plan (MDP) Public Open House: *The MDP Public Open House will be held on Saturday, August 24th, 2019 at the Darwell Seniors Hall – information will be mailed to all residents, posted on the Summer Village website and on the portable community information sign.*
3. Back alleys – will be assessed when it dries up: *Further to a July 15th assessment of the Summer Village alleys with the contractor, the alleys will be bladed and a few loads of gravel will be hauled into the really bad areas.*
4. Bugs remove leaves from 9th street ditch, and ditch to be reconfigured to be made wider and deeper: *The lawn crew has been requested to remove the leaves from the 9th street ditch.*
5. Resident Concern regarding Summer Village records for particular tax roll: *The tax roll information for this particular property was incorrect and has now been corrected.*
6. Drainage project: *The drainage project will proceed in accordance with the engineered drainage plan when the weather allows regardless of whether resident(s) are home, away or on holidays.*
7. Trees in park between 2nd and 1st street Admin to follow-up as to why only 1 o 4 flagged is to be removed: *Administration has followed up with the tree removal contractor who has assessed the trees in the various parks. Tree removal will be done in stages starting with the trees of highest concern.*
8. Washroom at large park – does Council wish to have a privy there for the remainder of 2019: *A porta-potty has now been placed at the ball diamond park for the remainder of the season.*

9. Sewage haulers: *Administration has asked haulers to use longer hoses and stay on hard surface whenever possible.*

10. Playground needs to be weed whacked: *Administration has advised the lawn to crew to weed whack inside the playground area as well, the weed inspector will be spraying in the area to control the growth.*

11. Are noise bylaws enforced in the lagoon area: *Administration is working with bylaw enforcement and will report back to Council.*
