

# **Summer Village of West Cove**

## **Boat Lift & Pier Section Removal Policy**

**Approved by Council: July 28, 2016**  
**Motion # 16-255**

### **Policy Statement**

The Summer Village of West Cove would like to have all privately owned boat lifts, pier sections and pier stands, removed from the public parks and parkways by June 1 of each year.

### **Reason for Policy**

The Summer Village of West Cove has deemed it necessary to remove the boats lifts, pier sections and pier stands to provide consistent park maintenance. Removal of these items also allows all residents in the Village free and unencumbered access to the parks and parkways.

### **Related Information**

The Summer Village of West Cove does allow for storage of privately owned boat lifts, pier sections and pier stands on the public parks and parkways during the period of September 1 to May 31 of each year. Storage of these items must be to the side of the park or parkway, as to not to interfere with public access to the lake.

Residents may contact the Summer Village Administration during regular office hours Monday through Friday to arrange for access through a locked gate to a park to remove their boat lift and/or pier sections.

### **Responsibilities**

It will be the responsibility of the Chief Administrative Officer or His/Her Designate to remove all privately owned boat lifts, pier sections and piers stands remaining on the parks or parkways between June 1 and September 1 of each year.

## **Disposition of Seized Equipment**

- Seized Equipment will be removed and stored at a secure location for a maximum of 30 days with all associated costs being charged to the equipment owner.
- To reclaim seized equipment within the 30 days, a removal fee of \$100.00 is owed to the Summer Village.
- After 30 days the seized equipment will be sold or destroyed, at the discretion of the municipality, with all associated costs being charged to the equipment owner.
